Basel gets bigger

An ambitious new art fair will be introduced to Basel this summer. VOLTAslow, founded by Friedrich Looock (Wohnmaschine, Berlin), Ulrich Voges (Voges + Partner, Frankfurt) and Kavi Gupta (Kavi Gupta Gallery, Chicago), is the latest addition to the new movement of non-profit project fairs made by galleries, for galleries. In fact, NADA stalwarts Zach Feuer and Bellwether and Zoo Art Fair founder David Risley are among the exhibitors. Promising to occupy the fertile middle ground between Art Basel and the youthful LISTE – which celebrates its 10th birthday this year – VOLTAslow looks set to become a permanent fixture on the calendar. www.voltashow.com
